Brooklyn Project To Create Senior Housing

[IMPACCT Brooklyn](#) (IB), previously known as Pratt Area Community Council, has a strong reputation as an advocate for low and moderate-income residents in Brooklyn. IB has identified the neighborhoods of central Brooklyn and Crown Heights as the “next battleground for gentrification and landlord abuse of tenants” and is countering that trend with program services that include creating homeownership opportunities, increasing affordable rental units, protecting tenant rights and combating predatory lending practices. Only four charter schools in the nation have received the designation as “[Centers of Excellence](#)” by the National Center for Special Education in Charter Schools (NCSECS) and the most recent charter public school to receive a Leviticus loan is one of them.
